

Morlaix adult ballet camp 2023

Terms and Conditions

1. Participants will be divided into groups by the coaching team.
2. The organization must be informed if the participant has any allergies or other health problems, and an accompanying letter must be submitted.
3. All participants must bring their own regular practice wear, including pointe shoes for female identifying students willing to participate on Pointe.
4. The organizers will not be held responsible for any damage or injury, however caused, to any person attending the course, nor for the loss of any property.
5. The organizers reserve the right to retain all or part of the course fees in the event of the applicant's withdrawal. Withdrawal within 6 weeks of the camp starting date will not be reimbursed.
6. The organizers reserve the right to change the teachers or artists in the event of illness or any other unavoidable causes.
7. The organizers reserve the right to cancel and/or change a part of the course or to cancel the entire course. If the course is cancelled, and only if this occurs, the organizers will only refund the course fees excluding any additional cost (f.ex.: accommodation and travel expenses). In case of change in part of the course, no reimbursement will be emitted.
8. It is recommended, as whenever traveling abroad, that the candidate takes out personal travel insurance.
9. No candidate can attend the course injured.
10. Photo- and video shots are property of « le petit ballet international » and can be used freely by « le petit ballet international » for promotional and marketing purposes.
11. All participants must have health insurance.
12. All participants must have liability insurance.
13. All participants younger than 18 years of age must send us, prior to the start of the course, the **Authorization for underage person** fully completed and signed by their parents or legal guardian. Participant needs to be at least 16 years old on the first day of the ballet camp.
